THE

BUILDING HORIZON JOURNEY

Horizon Church has a rich heritage in the Sutherland Shire, from its early beginnings as Sutherland AOG, founded by Pastor Norm Armstrong and his wife, Gwendoline in 1949 with the first service held in the local Sutherland School of Arts building.

The land on which our Sutherland Shire campus is currently located was purchased in 1954 and for decades it has seen thousands come to Christ. In the early 2000's as the church began to reach capacity of its then building, plans to rebuild were undertaken and in 2008, the new auditorium was opened. In 2017, through generous giving into the Vision Offering, the Nehemiah Project was launched which saw the full completion of the church's refurbishment to include a fully fitted out Basement for our children and youth, the installation of the Horizon Cafe and upgrades to the foyer. The Nehemiah projects were completed and paid for in full, without the need to incur any additional debt.

A VISION AND THE FIRST BRICK

Founding pastor Norm Armstrong saw land and a building in a vision. He responded to God's leading and trusted Him to provide a home for the church he began (with just 19 people, 9 of which were children!). Land and supernatural provision came.

A block of ground became available in Stapleton Avenue, Sutherland. It was purchased for £450. A Public Works inspector-named George Askew came along and became interested in the new building project. With his generous financial help to purchase the land and the help of many volunteers, work commenced on Tuesday 17th August 1954 at 9.30 a.m, with Pastor Norm Armstrong laying the first brick of a building designed for 250 people. It was dedicated on Saturday, 1st October 1955 during an AOG State conference.
